

AIM for Africa: Rwanda 2013

Project Dates: May 6-19, 2013

Location: Gisenyi, Rwanda

Transportation: Flights are booked and paid for individually

Cost: \$3,000, includes transportation, accommodations, food, interpreters, guides, and incidental expenses (\$800 will be paid to the Center in advance, flights will be purchased independently, and ground transportation will be paid individually)

Project Goals:

- To enhance the health and well-being of Rwandan residents through interdisciplinary and sustainable arts and health projects
- To provide UF students and faculty with meaningful learning through service and cultural exchange

2013 Project Teams:

1. Twa Dance Cooperative (2-3 strong dancers; experience with teaching, staging, and management helpful)
2. Twa Pottery Cooperative (2 ceramicists who can provide technical and creative guidance)
3. Twa Health Assessment (3-5 nursing, public health, or medical professionals/students)
4. Business Team (2-3 business professionals/students who can assist with refinement of the Twa Dance and Pottery Cooperative business structures and marketing plans)
5. Arts in Healthcare Train-the-trainer Program (1 students/professional to assist with training)

Required Meetings: Team members will be required to attend monthly evening meetings beginning the week of January 14, and every other week beginning the week of March 11.

Required Readings: Team members will be required to read several books and articles and view several films that are essential to project participation. The readings will be discussed at the team meetings, and due dates for each will be provided.

Other requirements include completion of immunizations, forms, and registration as well as payment of program fees and participation in project fundraising.
